SOCIAL ASSISTANCE POLICIES FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES IN VIETNAM TODAY

Abstract: The Communist Party and the State of Viet Nam have consistently prioritized the development and implementation of social welfare policies to ensure human rights for all, particularly vulnerable groups. The enhancement of social assistance policies is regarded as an important goal and driving force for promoting sustainable development and socio-political stability, reflecting the benevolent nature of the regime. The legal system and policies related to social security are continuously revised and improved, with an expanded scope of beneficiaries and an increased level of support. Investment resources in the development of social fields are also rising, encompassing both state budgets and other social resources. For persons with disabilities, social assistance policies have brought about significant changes in the provision of support services and in creating opportunities for their social integration and stability. This article analyzes current social assistance policies for persons with disabilities in Vietnam, highlighting the measures and policies the government has implemented in areas such as education, health care, employment, and preferential legal regulations. The article emphasizes the crucial role of these policies in fostering favorable and equitable conditions for the social inclusion of persons with disabilities.

1. INTRODUCTION
